Thank you for purchasing this Synology product. VS360HD is a live view and playback solution designed to supplement and enhance your Surveillance Station configuration.

VS360HD can be connected to HDMI and VGA displays, allowing you to easily operate most features of Surveillance Station without a computer.

# Safety Instructions

	Keep away from direct sunlight and away from chemicals. Make sure the environment does not experience abrupt changes in temperature or humidity.
	Place the product right side up at all times.
	Do not place near any liquids.

Note: If you do not need to mount VS360HD to your monitor, please skip to "Connect Inputs and Outputs".

# **Install Mounting Kit**

1 Place VS360HD upside down on a flat working surface (with the I/O ports facing towards you). Attach the mounting plate to VS360HD by installing the included s10 screws in the four spots illustrated below.



2 Prepare the monitor by powering it off and removing any connections to it. Then, place the monitor face down on a flat working surface (with the upper edge pointing away from you). Attach the mounting adapter to the monitor by installing the included s10 screws in accordance with your monitor mounting type.

**Note:** The mounting adapter is compatible with both MIS-D 75 and MIS-D 100 type VESA-compliant mounting surfaces.

**MIS-D 100** 

In the diagram below, the included s11 screws have been installed in accordance with the MIS-D 100 type:



3 Place VS360HD over the mounting adapter (with the I/O ports facing towards you). Align the screw holes and install the included s10 screws in the four spots illustrated below.



# **Connect Inputs and Outputs**

1 Connect one end of the AC power adapter to VS360HD and the other end to a power outlet.



2 Connect one end of the LAN cable to VS360HD and the other end to your switch/router/hub.



3 Connect one end of the HDMI and/or VGA cable to VS360HD and the other end to your monitor(s). In the diagram below, a VGA cable is attached.



Note: VS360HD supports dual displays. When two monitors are connected, the display is mirrored. 4 If you would like to attach a USB drive to VS360HD, connect it to the blue USB 3.0 port. Skip to the next step if this does not apply to you.



5 Connect your USB mouse or joystick to one of the USB ports. Skip to the next step if this does not apply to you.



6 Connect your USB keyboard to one of the USB ports. Skip to the next step if this does not apply to you.



7 Push the power button on the side panel of VS360HD. After booting up, VS360HD will be online and ready to work with your Synology NAS/NVR product.



**Note:** Upon powering on, VS360HD may take up to ten seconds to finish booting up. During this time, the display is blank.

## **Check Surveillance Station Software**

Before connecting VS360HD to your Synology NAS/NVR product, please make sure you have updated Surveillance Station to version 8.0 or later on your Synology NAS/NVR product in order to utilize all the new features.

#### To check your Surveillance Station version:

- 1 Sign in to your Synology NAS/NVR.
- 2 Go to Package Center.
- 3 Find and click Surveillance Station. The version number is displayed.



# Connect VS360HD to your Synology NAS/NVR

Once VS360HD is connected to the network and booted up, you can proceed to connect it to your Synology NAS/NVR product.

#### To connect VS360HD to your Synology NAS/NVR:

- 1 Launch Surveillance Station application on VS360HD.
- 2 Sign in to your Synology NAS/NVR using an account with the privilege of Surveillance Station. To enjoy full experience of Surveillance Station, you can use an account belonging to the administrator group.

4.2 Assignment. Customer will not assign any of its rights under this Warranty directly, by operation of law or otherwise, without the prior written consent of Synology.

4.3 No Additional Terms. Except as expressly permitted by this Warranty, neither party will be bound by, and each party specifically objects to, any term, condition or other provision that conflicts with the provisions of this Warranty that is made by the other party in any purchase order, receipt, acceptance, confirmation, correspondence or otherwise, unless each party specifically agrees to such provision in writing. Further, if this Warranty to any the any terms or conditions of any other agreement entered into by the parties with respect to the Product, this Warranty will prevail unless the other agreement specifically references the sections of this Warranty that it supersedes.

4.4 Applicable Law. Unless expressly prohibited by local law, this Warranty is governed by the laws of the State of Washington, U.S.A. without regard to any conflict of law principles to the contrary. The 1980 U.N. Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods or any successor thereto does not apply.

4.5 Dispute Resolution. Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Warranty, the Product or services provided by Synology with respect to the Product or the relationship between Customers residing within the United States and Synology will be resolved exclusively and finally by arbitration under the current commercial rules of the American Arbitration Association, except as otherwise provided below. The arbitration will be conducted before a single arbitrator. and will be limited solely to the dispute between Customer and Synology. The arbitration, or any portion of it, will not be consolidated with any other arbitration and will not be conducted on a class-wide or class action basis. The arbitration shall be held in King County, Washington, U.S.A. by submission of documents, by telephone, online or in person as determined by the arbitrator at the request of the parties. The prevailing party in any arbitration or legal action occurring within the United States or otherwise shall receive all costs and reasonable attorneys' fees, including any arbitration fee paid by the prevailing party. Any decision rendered in such arbitration proceedings will be final and binding on the parties, and judgment may be entered thereon in any court of competent jurisdiction. Customer understands that, in the absence of this provision, Customer would have had a right to litigate any such dispute, controversy or claim in a court, including the right to litigate claims on a class-wide or class-action basis, and Customer expressly and knowingly waives those rights and agrees to resolve any disputes through binding arbitration in accordance with the provisions of this Section 4.5. For Customers not residing within the United States, any dispute, controversy or claim described in this section shall be finally resolved by arbitration conducted by three neutral arbitrators in accordance with the procedures of the R.O.C. Arbitration Law and related enforcement rules. The arbitration shall take place in Taipei, Taiwan, R.O.C., and the arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in English or, if both parties so agree. in Mandarin Chinese. The arbitration award shall be final and binding on the parties and may be enforced in any court having jurisdiction. Nothing in this Section shall be deemed to prohibit or restrict Synology from seeking injunctive relief or seeking such other rights and remedies as it may have at law or equity for any actual or threatened breach of any provision of this Warranty relating to Synology's intellectual property rights.

4.6 Attorneys' Fees. In any arbitration, mediation, or other legal action or proceeding to enforce rights or remedies under this Warranty, the prevailing party will be entitled to recover, in addition to any other relief to which it may be entitled, costs and reasonable attorneys' fees.

4.7 Export Restrictions. You acknowledge that the Product may be subject to U.S. export restrictions. You will comply with all applicable laws and regulations that apply to the Product, including without limitation the U.S. Export Administration Regulations.

4.8 Severability. If any provision of this Warranty is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remainder of this Warranty will remain in full force and effect.

4.9 Entire Agreement. This Warranty constitutes the entire agreement, and supersedes any and all prior agreements, between Synology and Customer related to the subject matter hereof. No amendment, modification or waiver of any of the provisions of this Warranty will be valid unless set forth in a written instrument signed by the party to be bound thereby.

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
